In Aubenas, you can undergo hemodialysis at a dialysis center or in an outpatient dialysis unit, as well as through self-dialysis.

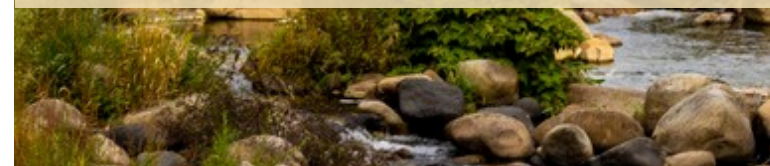
For patients wishing to undergo peritoneal dialysis, this is available at our Montélimar facility.

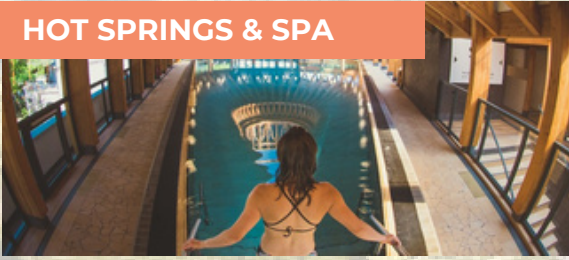

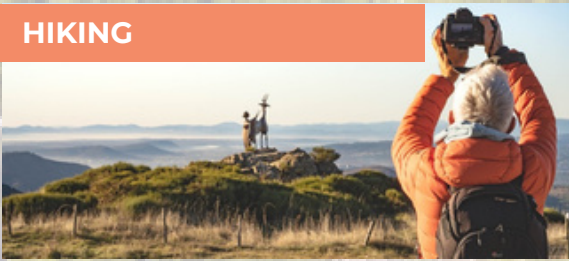
